

THE WEST VIRGINIA STATE SHOOT AT THOMAS.

E. H. McDonald Wins State Championship and Doubles; L. E. Dinsmore the Handicap.

SCORES made at the West Virginia State Shoot, held at Thomas on June 14, 15 and 16, were received by SPORTSMEN'S REVIEW via the A. T. A. office, on July 8, without any marks to indicate the winners.

From a careful check of the scores they appear to be: E. H. McDonald, Keyser, W. Va., state 16-yard champion on a score of 188x200, shot on the last 100 of the 150 targets on June 15, of which he broke 93, and the 100 on June 16, when he scored 95. He also won the doubles championship, 38x25 pair. L. E. Dinsmore, St. Marys, Va., won the state handicap, with 88x100 from 17 yards.
